

**2010 SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES  
for Graduating New Jersey High School Seniors**

**Alfred J. Speak Scholarship**

The purpose of the Alfred J. Speak Scholarship is to support the education of boys, girls, young men and young women of the State of New Jersey, so that they will be assisted in developing their moral, mental, intellectual and physical well being, and in later years will make better and more useful and enlightened citizens to the ultimate benefit of mankind. This fund provides scholarships to deserving and disadvantaged individuals to assist them in attending any educational institution in the United States.

*Please note that preference will be given to students residing in the City of Newark, Essex County, who are affiliated with the Boys and Girls Club of Newark and the First Presbyterian Church (Broad Street, Newark.)*

**Award: Five (5) scholarships in the amount of \$5,000, payable in four equal annual installments of \$1,250.**

**J. Oscar & Susan Florence Hunt Scholarship**

The purpose of the J. Oscar & Susan Florence Hunt Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to worthy men and women of any race, color, or religious belief, to enable them to pursue academic studies at an institution of higher learning of their choice located in the United States of America. The scholarships will be awarded based on need and merit.

*Only New Jersey residents who reside in Gloucester and Salem Counties may apply. Preference is to be given to the residents of Swedesboro, Auburn, Pedricktown and Penns Grove, in order priority stated.*

Continued eligibility for the J. Oscar & Susan Florence Hunt Scholarship is contingent on student maintaining a 2.5 GPA or better. Student will be required to submit a letter of request for subsequent payments each year verifying that student continues to be enrolled in school and continues to meet all eligibility requirements.

**Award: Four (4) scholarships of \$4,260, payable in four equal annual installments of \$1,065.**

### **Dominique Lisa Pandolfo Scholarship**

Dominique Lisa Pandolfo was an extraordinary young woman who lived each day to the fullest. On September 10, 2001, Dominique started her first day at New York University Graduate School. On September 11, 2001, Dominique became a victim of the attack on the World Trade Center. This scholarship's goal is to perpetuate Dominique's memory by helping young women to develop their potential, achieve their goals and become successful adults and proud Americans. The scholarship hopes to instill in each recipient the same spirit and zest for life that was so abundant in Dominique.

The scholarship will be awarded to a female student, as nominated by the Dominique Lisa Pandolfo Scholarship Committee, who best exemplifies the criteria stated above, with an emphasis placed on financial need. The awardee will be a student whose scholarship, character, personality and leadership qualities are regarded as outstanding. The student may not necessarily be the top student in the class, but she will have shown outstanding potential, merit and/or improvement.

**Award: One (1) scholarship in the amount of \$5,000 payable in four annual installments of \$1,250.**

### **Clanseer & Anna Johnson Scholarship**

The Clanseer & Anna Johnson Scholarship Fund is to provide financial assistance to disadvantaged African American students who were born in the United States and reside in New Jersey. Students must have obtained an average of "A" or "B" on subjects relating to the sciences or mathematics, and maintain above average grades overall in whatever curriculum they are pursuing. The scholarships will be awarded based on need and merit.

**Award: Four (4) scholarships of \$6,000 each, payable in four equal annual installments of \$1,500.**

### **Harry H. Loudenslager Scholarship**

The Harry H. Loudenslager Scholarship was created under the will of Henry C. Loudenslager in memory of his deceased son. The purpose of the Harry H. Loudenslager Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a worthy young man who is a resident of Camden, Gloucester, Salem, Cumberland or Cape May Counties in New Jersey.

Only male New Jersey residents who reside in Camden, Gloucester, Salem, Cumberland or Cape May Counties may apply. Applicants must have been admitted to a college or university as of the date their application is submitted.

**Award: Two (2) non-renewable scholarships of \$1,075 each, payable in a lump sum for the upcoming academic year.**

### **Elizabeth Clark Loudenslager Scholarship**

The Elizabeth Clark Loudenslager Scholarship was created under the will of Henry C. Loudenslager in memory of his deceased daughter. The purpose of the Elizabeth Clark Loudenslager Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a worthy young woman who is a resident of Camden, Gloucester, Salem, Cumberland or Cape May Counties in New Jersey.

Only female New Jersey residents who reside in Camden, Gloucester, Salem, Cumberland or Cape May Counties may apply. Applicants must have been admitted to a college or university as of the date their application is submitted.

**Award: Two (2) non-renewable scholarships of \$1,095 each, payable in a lump sum for the upcoming academic year.**

### **General Administration Information**

All scholarships awarded are made payable to the student's college/university. Scholarship aid from the Community Foundation of New Jersey is conditioned on the school the student will attend agreeing that the aid should be applied to the student's unmet need or loans first. If after all need has been met scholarship monies remain, it may be used to displace school provided aid in the following progression: work-study and then grants.
